


"It takes a whole village to raise a child," says an African proverb.

Lastly, I would like to express my heartiest gratitude to Mr. N.Vig for his help and guidance and also my other team members for their support and cooperation.






St Andrew's house asserted its superiority over the game pocketing the football shield.

THE INDIAN NUCLEAR DETERRENT

During and even after the Cold War era, nuclear material and missile proliferation spread to several countries. These countries, which indude Iraq. Iran and Pakistan, gained help from nuclear powers such as China, and started rapid assembling of their nuclear arsenals. Pretty soon even after arms reduction treaties between the U.S. and the erswhile Soviet Union, the number of nuclear warheads and missiles has grown increasingly large.

The largest number of nuclear-weapons equipped countries are in India's close proximity. These are Pakistan, Iran, Iraq, China, Malaysia, the former Soviet countries, and of course, the US strategic bombers base on the island of Diego





Garcio, 1000 miles South of Sri Lanka. Such a dangerous situation forced the Indian scientists at DRDO (Defence Research and Development Organization) to start the Integrated Guided Missiles Research and Development Programme (IGMDP). Within this programme, work was started on two nuclear capable missiles, the Prithvi and the Agni, and three conventional missiles. Akash, a short range surface to air missile, Trishul, a long range air defence missile, and Nag, a long range anti-tank missile.

Prithvi and Agni form the backbone of the Indian nuclear deterrent. Both are unlike the missiles developed by other countries. Both are road mobile, both have manuverable trajectories, and both can carry upto a tonne of all types of warheads. Both are currently in production, along with their various versions which have been developed.

Prithvi is a short range liquid fuelled road mobile, nuclear-capable missile. Its special computerized and radar-guided tracking system allows it to be used as an all- weather offensive system against enemy armoured tank columns. A special Soviet design truck built to carry the Prithvi can allow it to deploy full strike capability status within fifteen minutes. The Prithvi is available in three versions. Prithvi-1 with a range of 150 km, Prithvi-2 with a range of 250 km, and Dhanush, the 350 km range naval version is under development.

Agni is the Indian Intermediate Range Ballistic Missile (IRBM) with a slated range of upto 2500 km. It is road- mobile, nuclear capable, two- stage solid fuel missile. It has been designed to deep strike at important energy cities. Its most powerful version, Agni-II, can carry a 45-kiloton atomic or a smaller thermonuclear device. It is also available in three versions, Agni-I, with a 1,500 km range, Agni-II with a 2,500 km range, and Agni-III or Surya-I which is slated as an ICBM with a 5000 km range, is under development. To strengthen its defence against nuclear missiles, India is trying to obtain the Arrow ABM system from Israel and the S-300 from Russia.

The Indian nuclear capability has been designed keeping Pakistan and China's overt nuclear arsenals in mind. It is yet to be seen how far the deterrent will be successful in the long run.



India demanded to stop infiltration and ban terrorism activities in POK,


"It is freedom struggle", Musharraf says.

On the Science Exhibition (Jan 2002)

Save our Mother Earth

Around the world, pollution of the air and water from municipal, industrial and agricultural operations continues to grow. Governments and industries are constantly on the look out for technologies that will allow for more efficient and cost-effective waste treatment. One technology that can successfully treat the organic fraction of wastes is anaerobic digestion (AD). When used in a fully engineered system, AD not only provides pollution prevention, but also allows for sustainable energy, compost and nutrient recovery. Thus, AD can convert a disposal problem into a profit centre. As the technology continues to mature, AD is becoming a key method for both waste reduction and recovery of a renewable fuel and other valuable co-products.

At St. Francis' College we recently organized a highly informative science exhibition. The visitors could witness a model of a Biogas plant. We even gave the following information to those who desired to make their own biogas.

Recycling waste into a fuel - BIOGAS

Requirements:-

A box with a lid, gas tube and a burner, a 'T' tube with a tap, suction pump, fresh cowdung, remains of plants and leaves, peels of vegetables.

Method:-

Mix all garbage (vegetable peels broken into pieces) with fresh cow-dung. Fill half the box with this mixture. Suck out the air to create a vacuum. Close the tap and leave it for decomposition by bacteria in the absence of air. The gases released by activities of microbes can be used as a fuel and the solid left behind is excellent manure with very high nitrogen content.

The students of our college had also put up many well-made charts on various important issues. We realized that our main objective should be spreading awareness among the visitors about the degrading condition of the global



environment. We therefore highlighted the following environmental problems:

- India covers about 2 percent of the earth's surface.
- 2. India's forested area is only 1 per cent of the world's forested area.
- 3. India's population is 18 percent of the world's total population.
- 30% of India's population depends on forests.
- 5. 74 % of India's forested area needs to be rehabilitated.
- 6. About 6 lakh tons of air is there in earth's atmosphere.
- 7. A healthy person breathes 22,000 times in a day.
- 8. In a day a healthy person takes in 35 pounds of air.
- 9. A healthy person breathes out 50 lakh liters of air in a year.
- During its lifetime a Peepal tree takes in about 2252 kgs of polluted air and gives our 1703 kgs of oxygen.

Most of our visitors were shocked when they got to know of facts like the ones below:

Since 1910 till today 0.05% Oxygen has been reduced. On the other hand 13% carbon dioxide has increased.


Since 2000 the temperature has increased by 0.3 degrees centigrade. Forests take in Carbon dioxide from 20-100%. Only 4% of the world's water is on Earth. The rest is in the oceans and in the form of ice. Available pure water is only 0.03%

In developing nations 80% children die due to diseases caused by water pollution.

I am sure that this effort of our College has enlightened many people, who will hopefully remember to be more ecologically friendly in the future.


हँसने लायक

बरमुडा चिभुज का रहस्य

(कुछ जानकारी समाचार पत्र द्वारा)

बरमूडा त्रिभुज का रहस्य लम्बे समय से उपन्यास लेखकों और हॉलीवुड के सिनेमा निर्माताओं की पसंदीदा विषय वस्तु रहा है। अमेरिका के फ्लोरिडा स्ट्रेट के पास समुद्र के मध्य स्थित इस जगह के बारे में मशहूर है कि यहां से गुजरने वाले जलपोत और वायुयान गायब हो जाते है। १६१८ में अमेरिकी नौ परिवहन पोत साइक्लोप्स और १६६३ में एस० एस० मैरीन सल्फर जैसे भारी भरकम जहाज गायब हो जाने के बाद इस धारणा को और बल मिला। नाविकों और विमान चालकों में भय का पर्याय बन चुके इस क्षेत्र की सच्चाई का पता लगाने की कोशिशों पर मिथक हमेशा ही भारी पड़े है। लम्बे समय तक यह माना जाता रहा कि यह स्थान अंतरिक्ष से आई उड़न तश्तरियों का अड्डा है और अज्ञात अंतरिक्षवासी अपने प्रयोगों के लिए जलपोतों और वायुयानों को मनुष्यों समेत उठा ले जाते हैं। अब एक वैज्ञानिक अध्ययन ने बरमूडा के रहस्य से पर्दा उठाने की कोशिश की है।

नए अध्ययन में दस साल लगे हैं और यह वैज्ञानिक दृष्टिकोण के काफी निकट है। १६६० में भूवैज्ञानिक को इस रहस्य के बार में पहला सुराग हाथ लगा, जब उन्होंने बहामा के पास समुद्र तल से मीथेन गैस को बड़ी मात्रा में निकलती देखी। यदि उस समय उस स्थान से कोई जहाज गुजार रहा हो तो पानी का घनत्व घट जाने के कारण वह निश्चित ही डूब जाएगा। इसी वजह से जलपोतों के दिशासूचक यंत्र भी गड़बड़ा जाते है। उठती हुई मीथेन रहस्यमय कोहरे का भ्रम पैदा कर देती है।

२ दिसम्बर, २००० को न्यू साइटिस्ट पत्रिका में छपी एक रिपोर्ट के मुताबिक सदरलैण्ड विश्वविद्यालय के वैज्ञानिकों ने उत्तरी समुद्र की सतह में ४५० फीट नीचे दबी एक मछली भार नौका को खोज निकाला। यह नौका 'डायन के खड्डे' या विच होल में फंसी हुई थी। विच होल को सरल भाषा में समुद्र में मीथेन गैस का ज्वालामुखी कह सकते हैं। बरमूडा क्षेत्र में भी ऐसा ही पाया गया। परन्तु वैज्ञानिक यह पता करने में असमर्थ रहे कि वायुयान कैसे गायब हो जाते है अतः बरमूडा के कुछ रहस्य अभी भी अछूते है।
